The Executive Director of Rhode Island Infrastructure Bank (“RIIB” or “Bank”) proposes the adoption of the IUP to apply for all funds made available by the Safe Drinking Water Act Amendments of 1996 to the State of Rhode Island. Written comments on the proposed document should be sent to the Bank at the above address within twenty (20) days of the date of this notice. Requests for a public hearing should also be made within twenty (20) days.

A public hearing on the proposed document will be held if the Bank receives such a request from twenty-five (25) people, a governmental agency or subdivision, or an association having not less than twenty-five (25) members. If a public hearing is held, a public notice will be published announcing the date, time and place of such hearing.

The Bank, in accordance with Section 42-35.2 of the RI General Laws as amended, has considered alternative approaches to the proposed document and has determined that the proposed document does not overlap or duplicate other regulatory or statutory provisions nor will they result in significant adverse economic impact on small businesses.
